TRAINING

ALL PLAYERS (seniors and juniors), coaches, officials and volunteers MUST REGISTER on the Sports TG 'Return to Activity Register' BEFORE ATTENDING TRAINING.

There is no cost to register and here is the link: http://www.sunshinebaseball.com.au/registration/

All players, coaches, assistants and volunteers' names will be recorded at each training session and sent into Baseball Victoria and they will cross check them with the Sports TG Return to Activity Register. Further details on how names will be recorded electronically at training sessions will be provided soon.

Juniors and seniors can only train in groups of 20 and only 2 groups per field allowed. (Groups of 20 include coaches and assistants)

All players, coaches and volunteers must use hand sanitiser before, during and after training. Hand sanitiser must be applied for members to obtain access to the field

Masks and other approved face coverings must be worn at all times, the only time a mask can be removed or lowered is where there is a reasonable expectation that the athlete will need to run or immediately undertake activity that causes the athlete to breathe deeply or in a 'puffing' motion.

Groups are not to mix during training, they must stay within the same group on the day of attendance.

Parents will be able to attend training with children in limited numbers while maintaining social distancing. No other spectators are permitted at training.

Once we receive approval to use the clubrooms entry will only permitted to use the toilet and you will need to sanitise before entry and at exit.

There is no use of change room facilities. No showers after training or entering the clubrooms.

EQUIPMENT

All players will need to use their own equipment: glove, bat, helmet or any other gear or equipment. Sharing of bats is discouraged and require cleaning between uses.

Helmets: all players must have their own helmet for the first game. Players may acquire their own however it is anticipated there will be a high demand by all clubs to acquire helmets, retail stocks are already limited. To assist SBC will be stocking Junior and Senior helmets: stocks are due in mid to late November, but pre-ordering as soon as possible is highly recommended.
